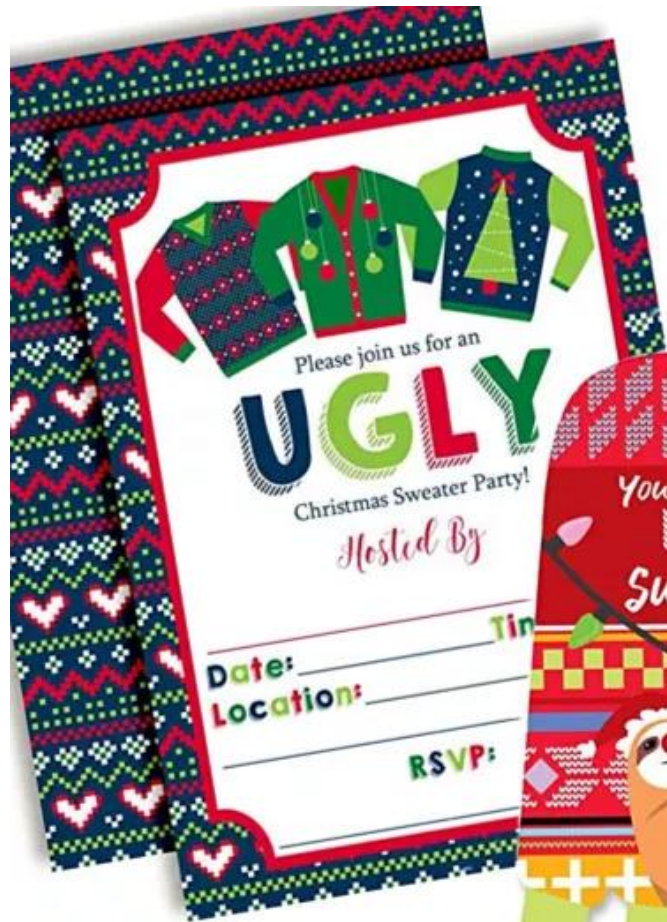


# FUN UGLY SWEATER INVITATIONS


